



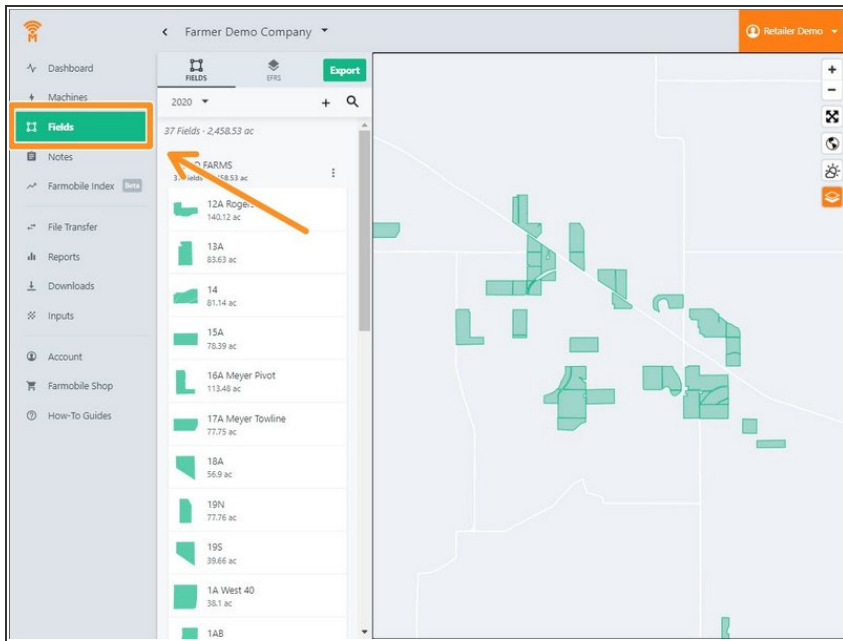

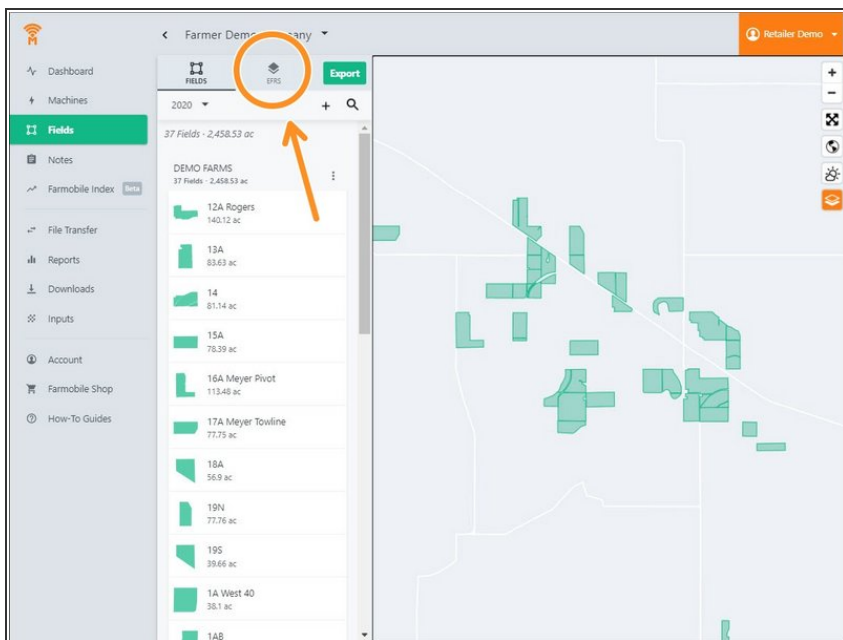

Step 1 — Navigate to Fields



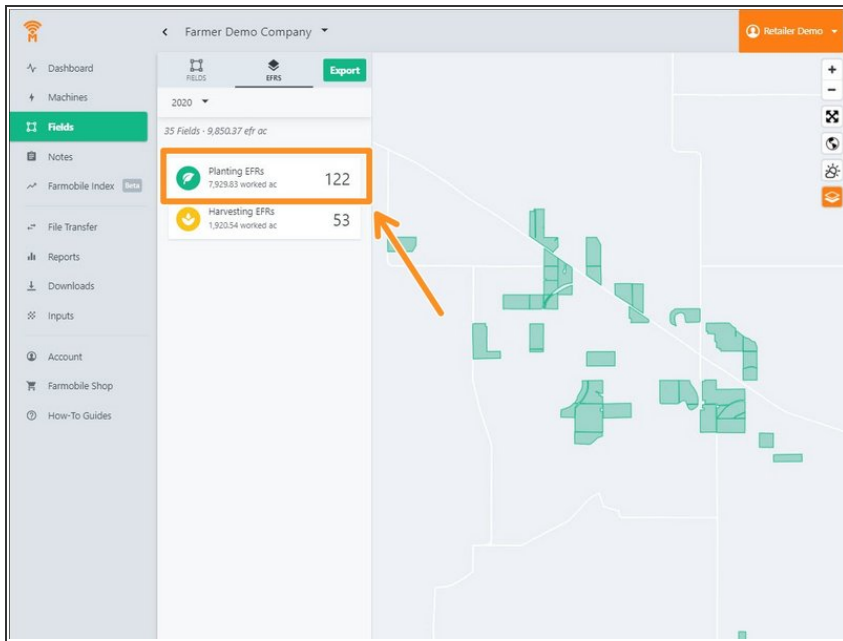
- Select 'Fields' in the Farmobile DataEngineSM platform menu to navigate to your fields.

Step 2 — Select the EFRs Tab



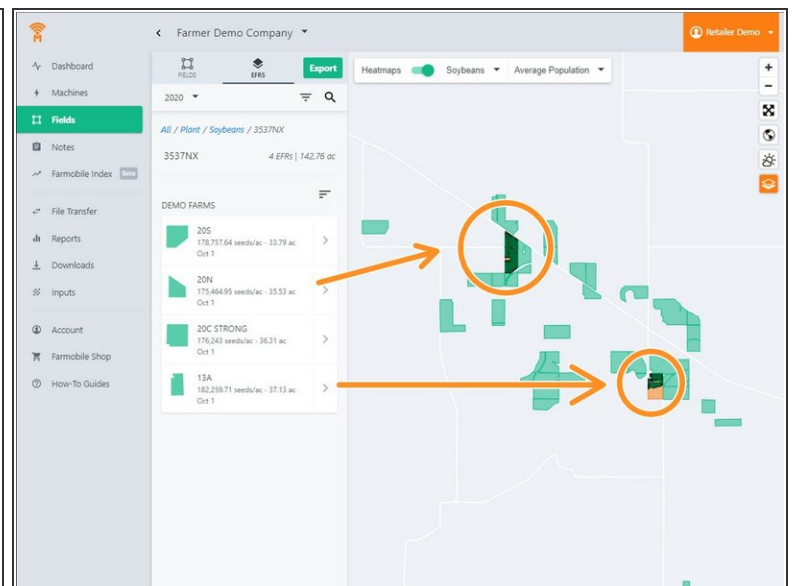
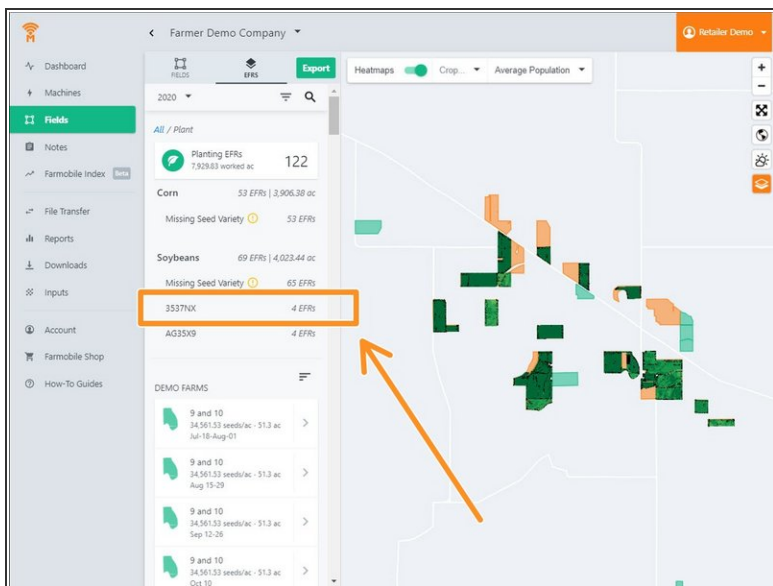
- Select the 'EFRs' tab to view and interact with your EFR data.

Step 3 — Select the Planting Activity



- Select the Planting Activity Tile to view the list of EFRs for that activity and enable the sort EFR tool.

Step 4 — Select the Variety you would like to display



- Scroll down to the Crop and select the Variety you would like to filter the fields down to.
- The list on the left as well as the map on the right should filter down to only show the fields that have been planted with the variety selected.
