



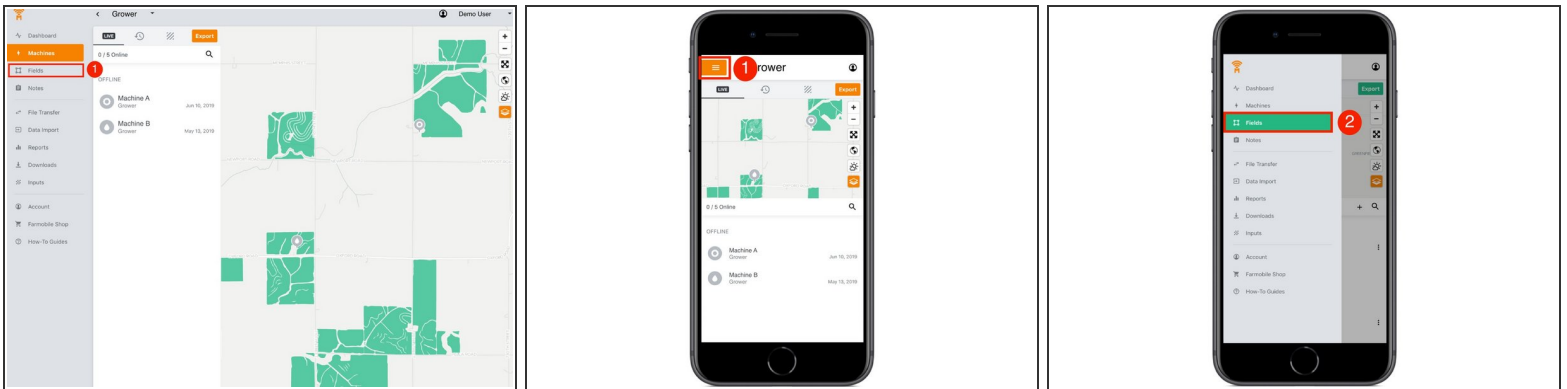
# Delete EFR

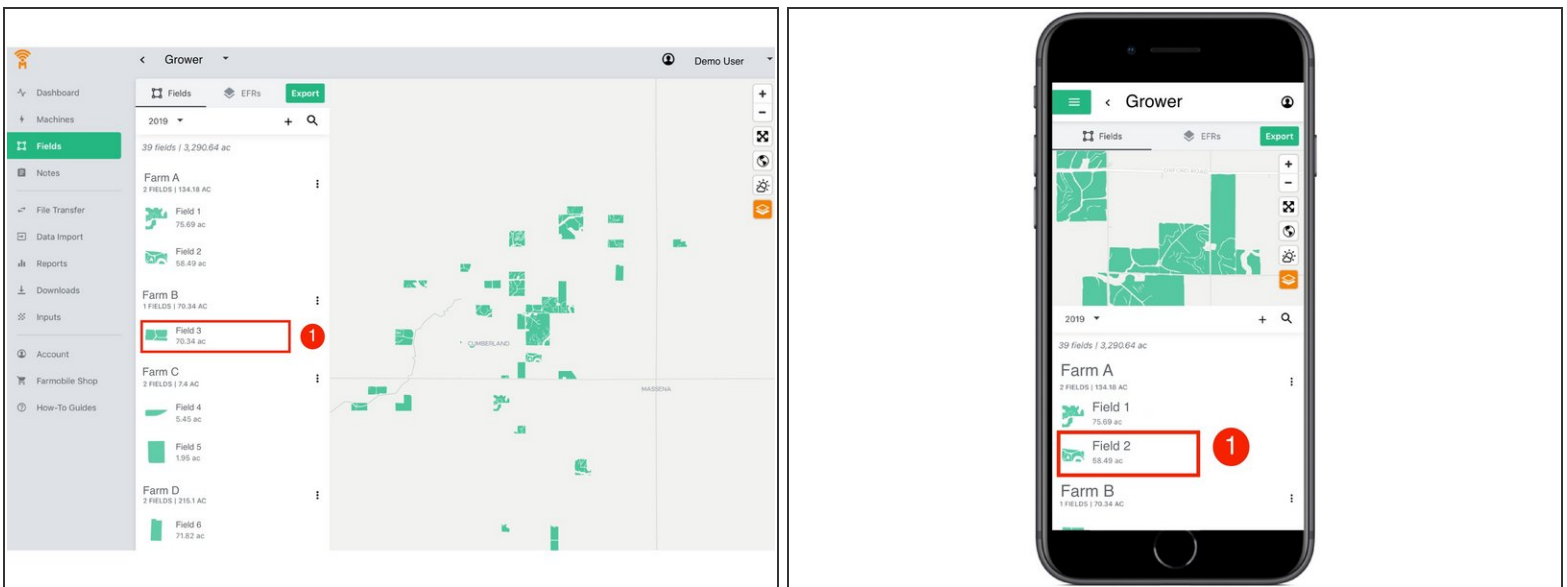

## Step 1 — Navigate to Fields



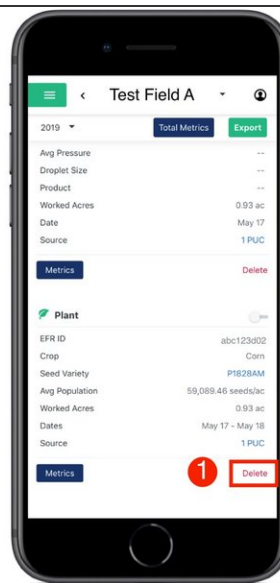
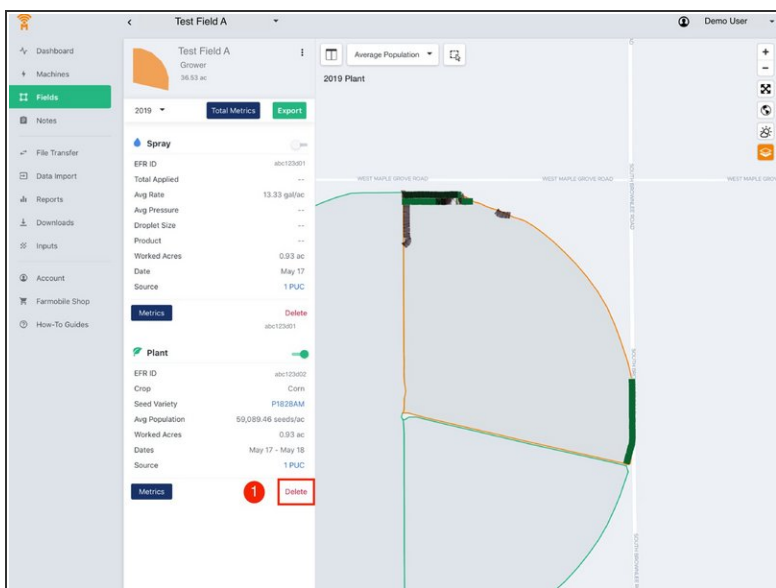
- Select 'Fields' in the Farmobile DataEngine platform menu to navigate to your fields.

- Select a field to view which EFRs need to be deleted.

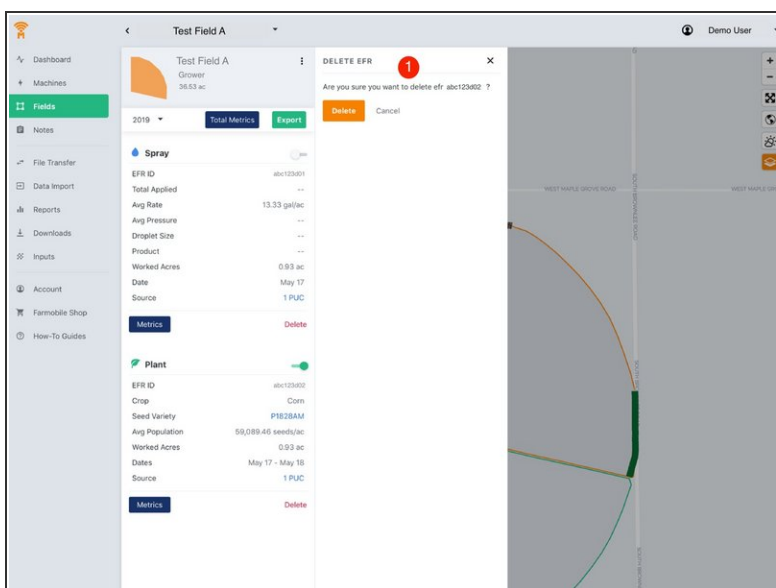
## Step 3 — Select Delete



- Select 'Delete' to remove an EFR that is not needed.

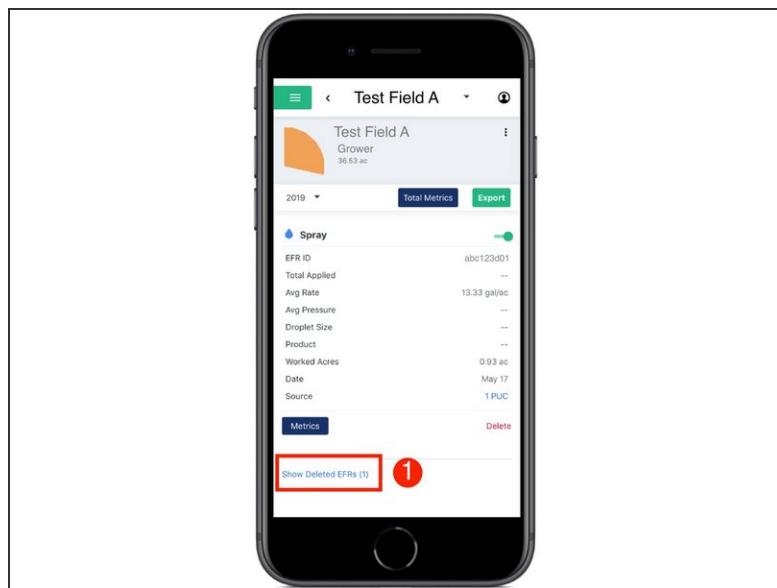
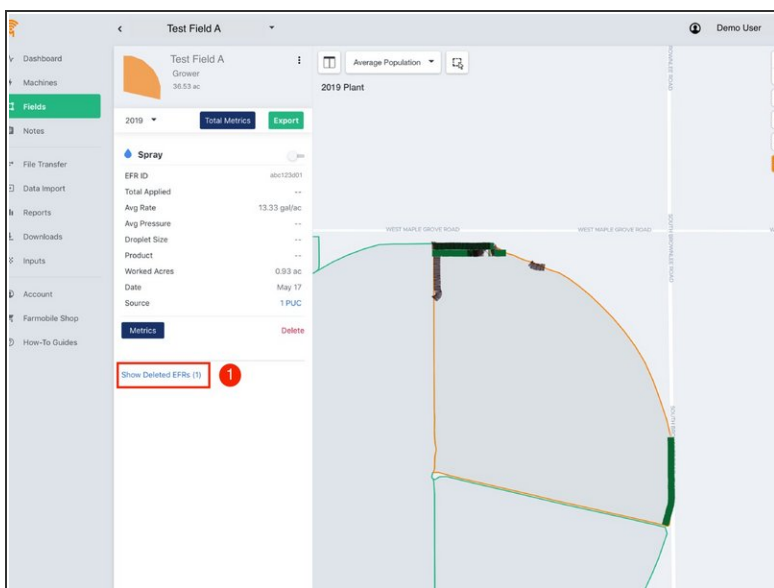
 Certified EFRs cannot be deleted.
