Step 1 — Navigate to Fields



● Select 'Fields' in the Farmobile DataEngine[™] platform menu to navigate to your fields.

Step 2 — Select a Field



Select a field to view which EFRs need to be deleted.

Step 3 — View a Deleted EFR



 At the bottom of the selected fields EFR list, select the 'Show Deleted EFRs' link to view the deleted EFRs.

Step 4 — Select Restore
