



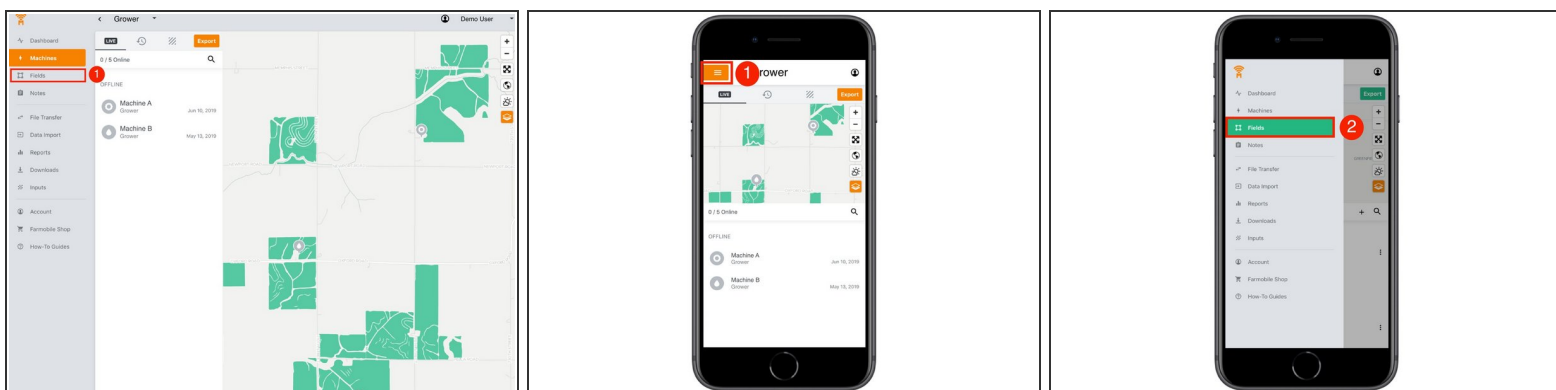

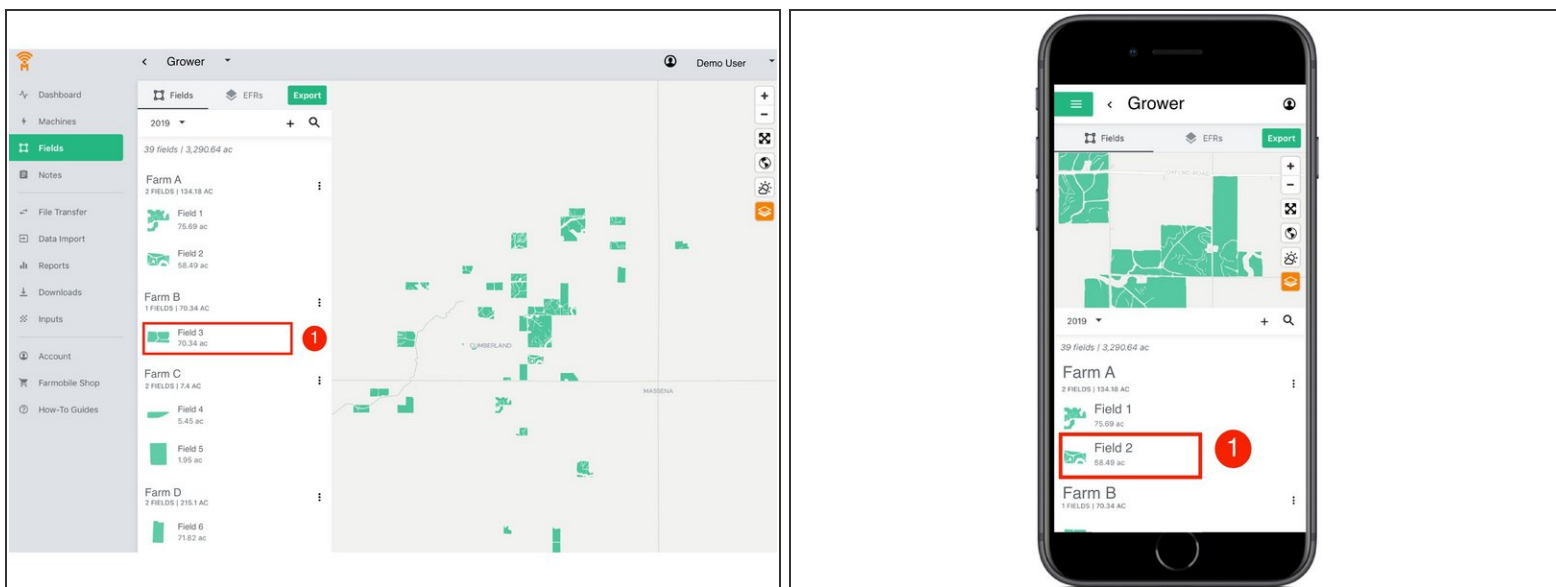

## Step 1 — Navigate to Fields



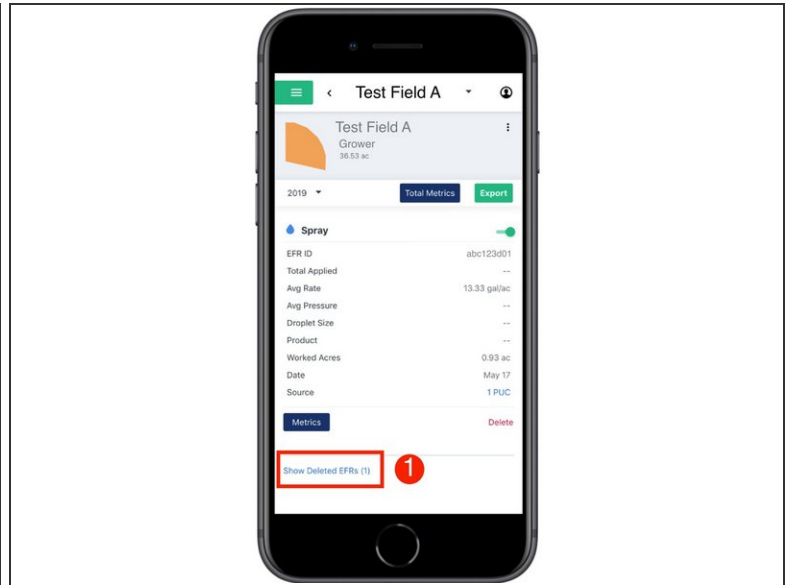
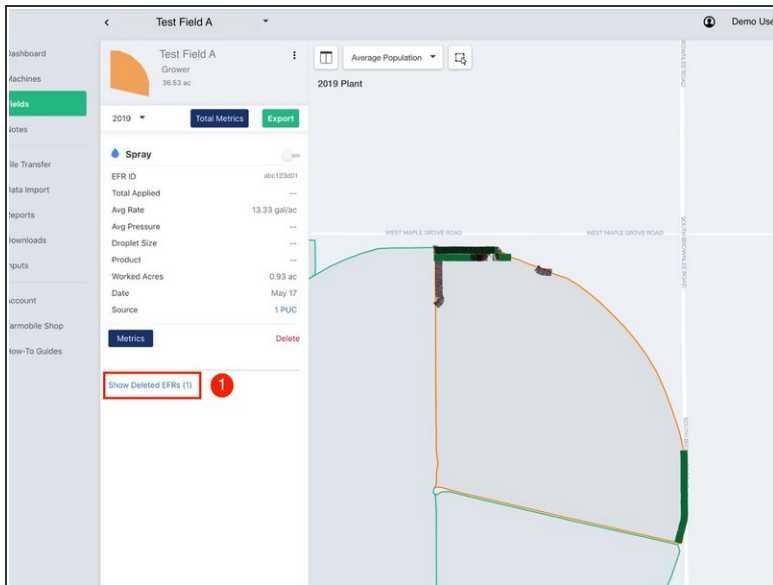
- Select 'Fields' in the Farmobile DataEngine<sup>SM</sup> platform menu to navigate to your fields.

## Step 2 — Select a Field



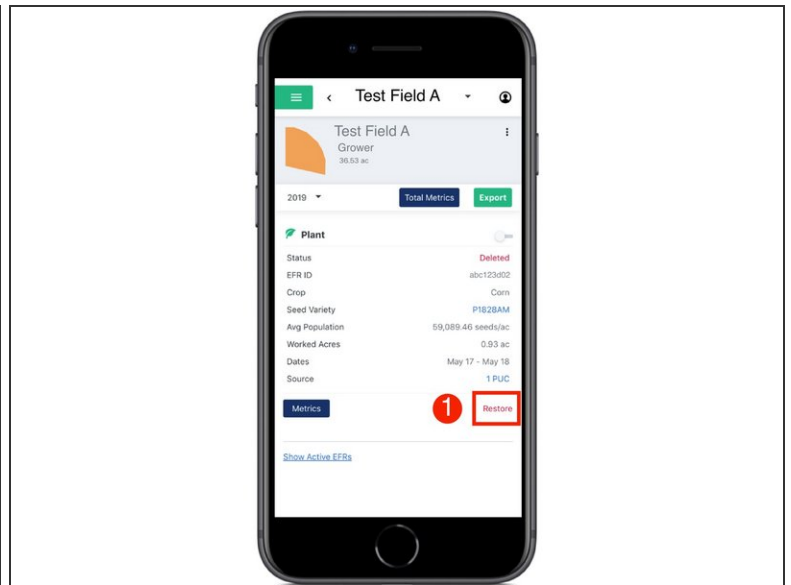
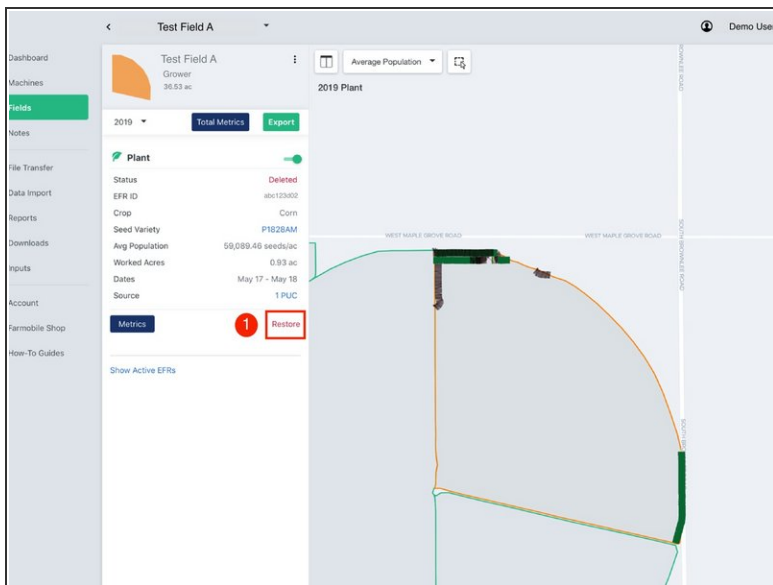
- Select a field to view which EFRs need to be deleted.

## Step 3 — View a Deleted EFR



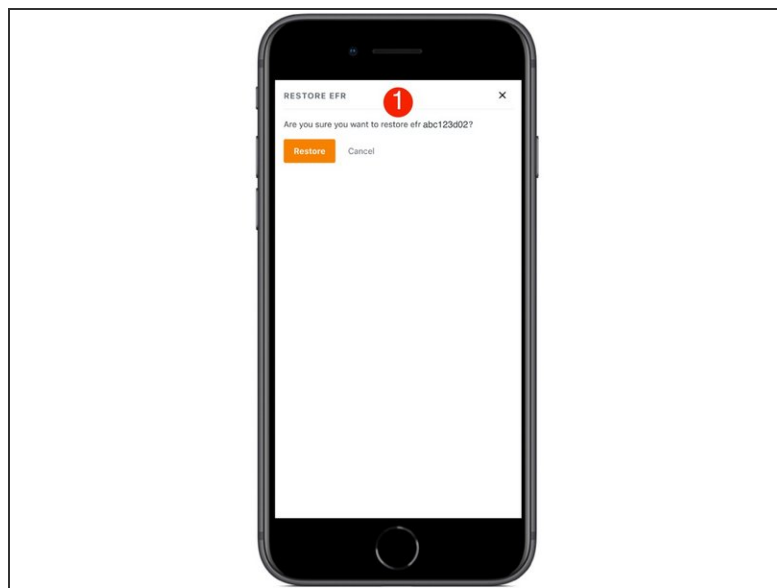
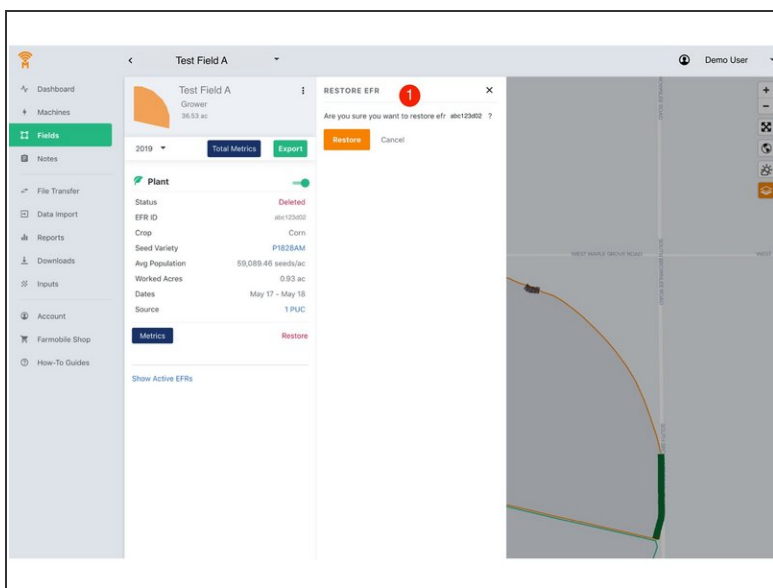
- At the bottom of the selected fields EFR list, select the 'Show Deleted EFRs' link to view the deleted EFRs.

## Step 4 — Select Restore



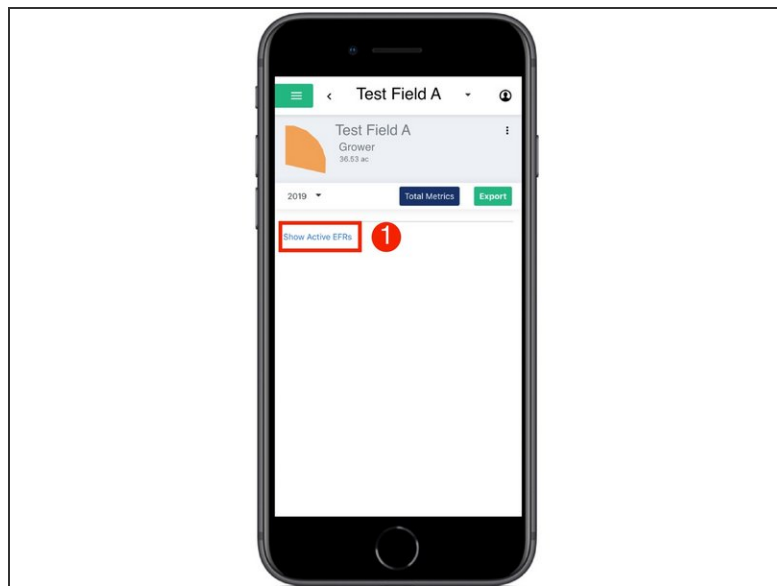
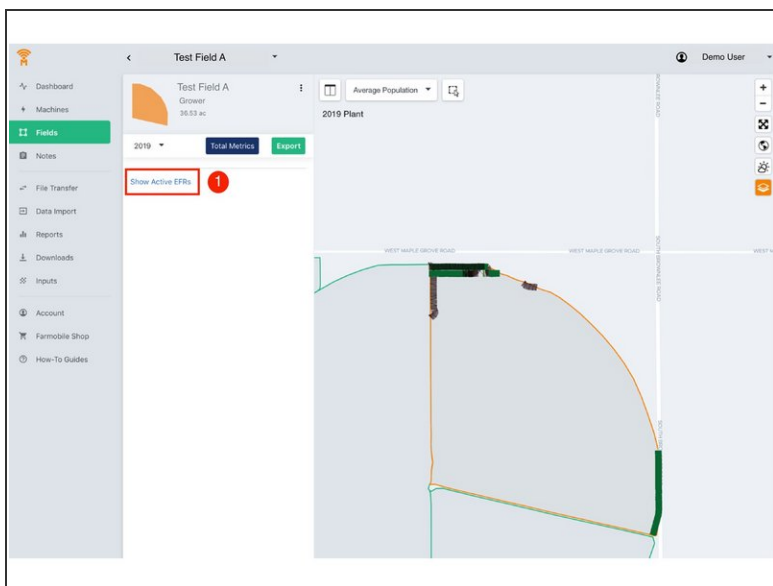
- While reviewing the deleted EFR, select 'Restore' to activate the EFR again.
- ❗ Restoring an EFR will move it back to the active EFR list.

## Step 5 — Confirm Restore EFR



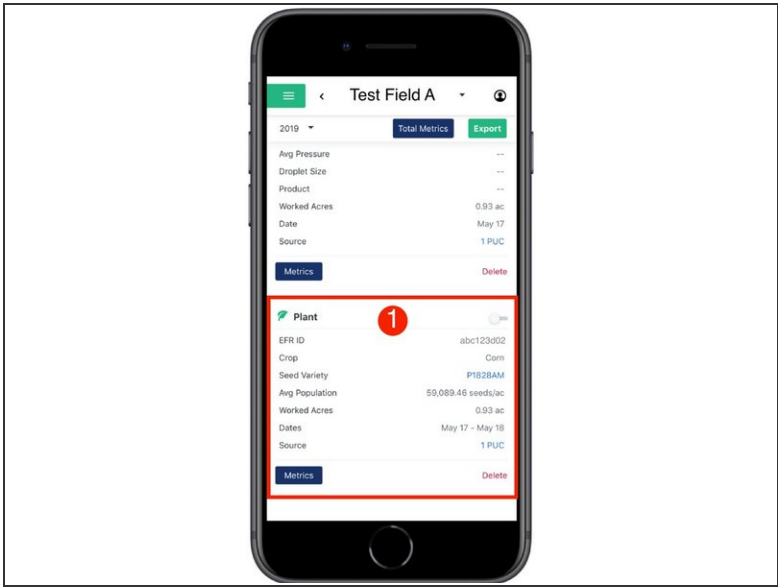
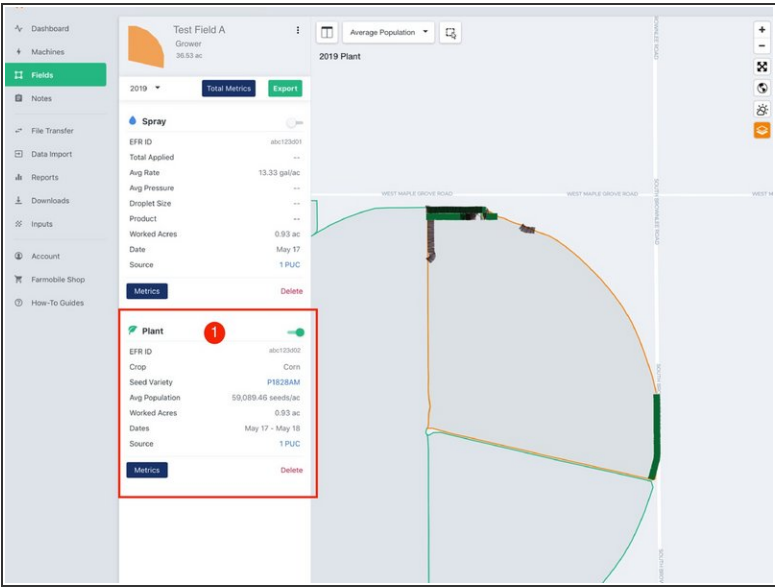
- Select the 'Restore' button to confirm your edit and make the EFR active again.

## Step 6 — Show Active EFRs



- Select the 'Show Active EFRs' link to view all active EFRs for the selected field.
