



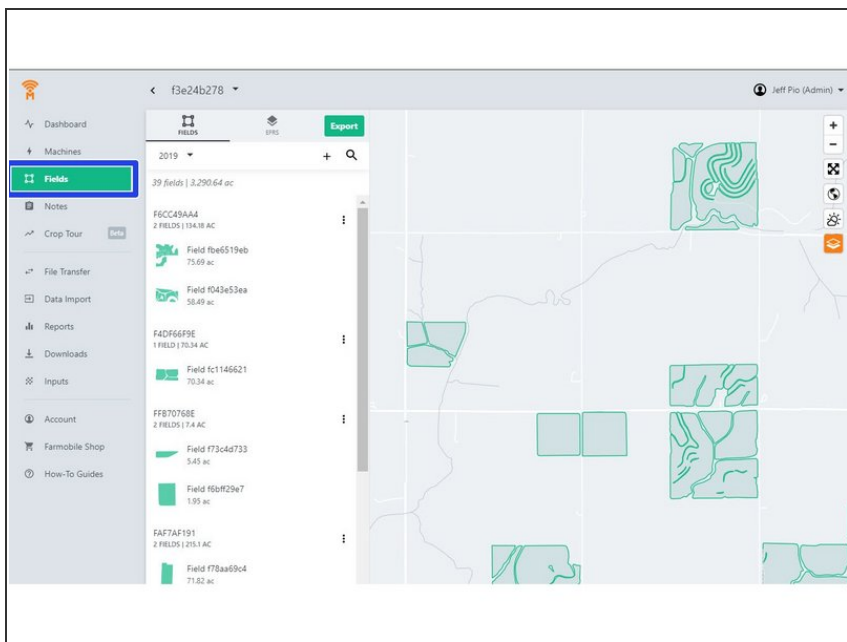

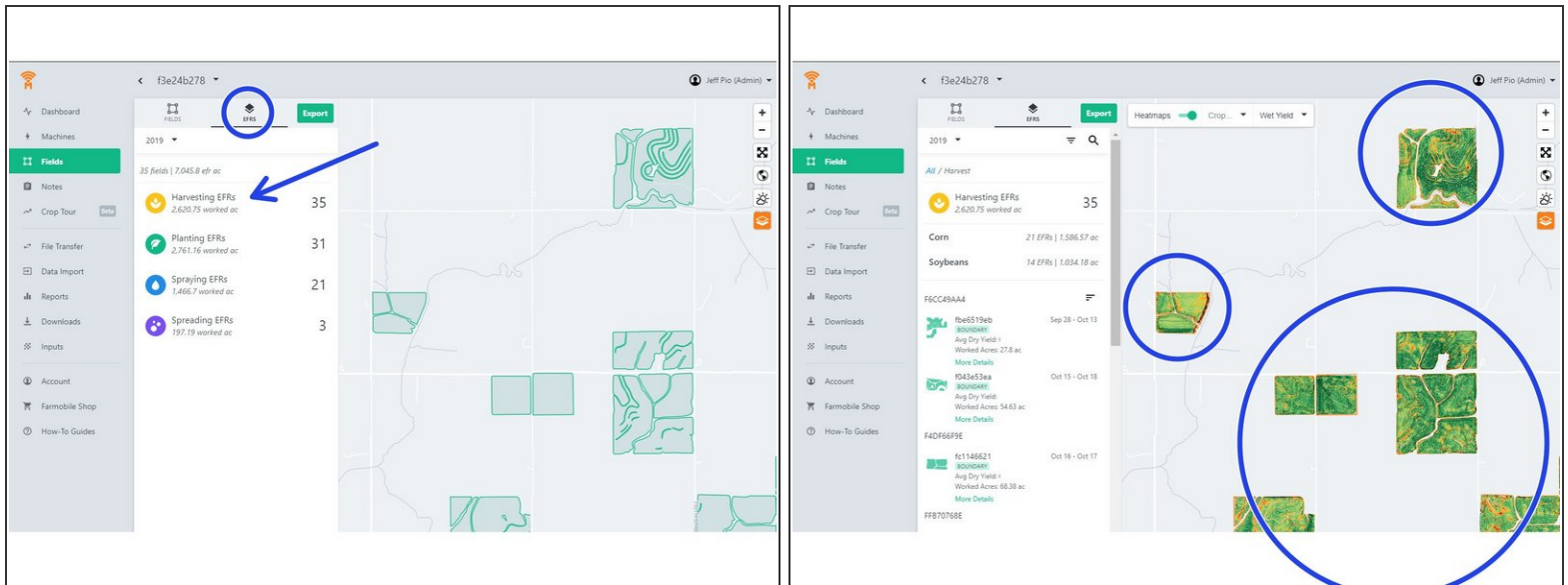

Step 1 — Select Fields



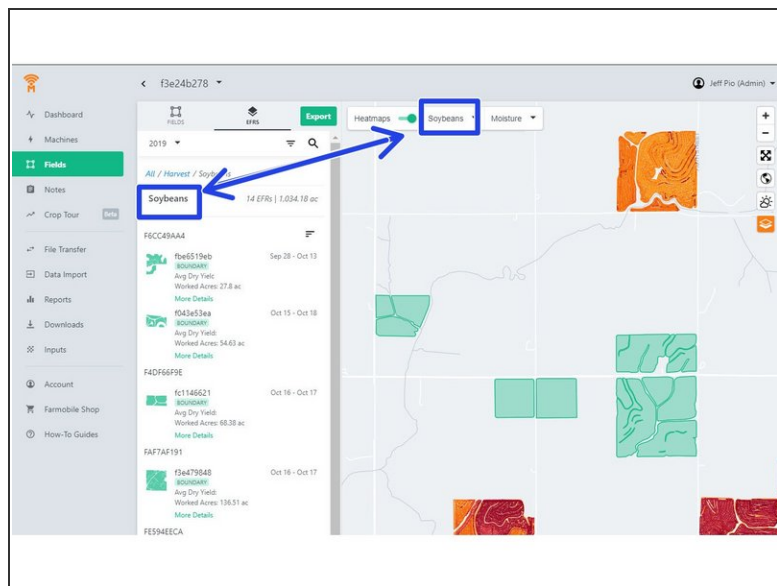
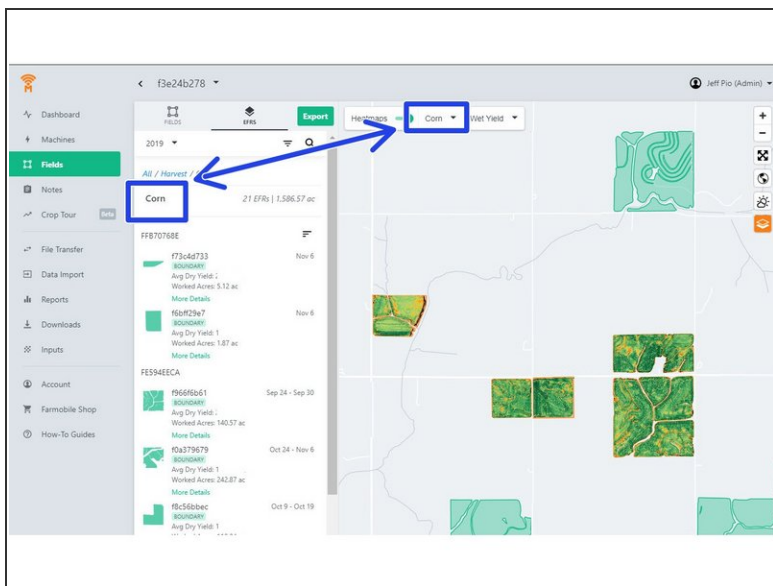
- To begin seeing heatmaps from a Field Level view, navigate to the Fields tab from on your Farmobile DataEngineSM platform.

Step 2 — Selecting EFR activities



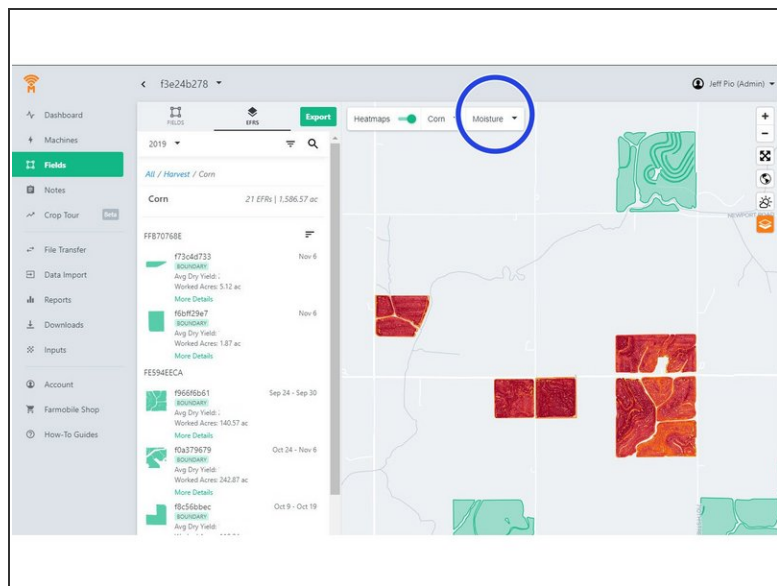
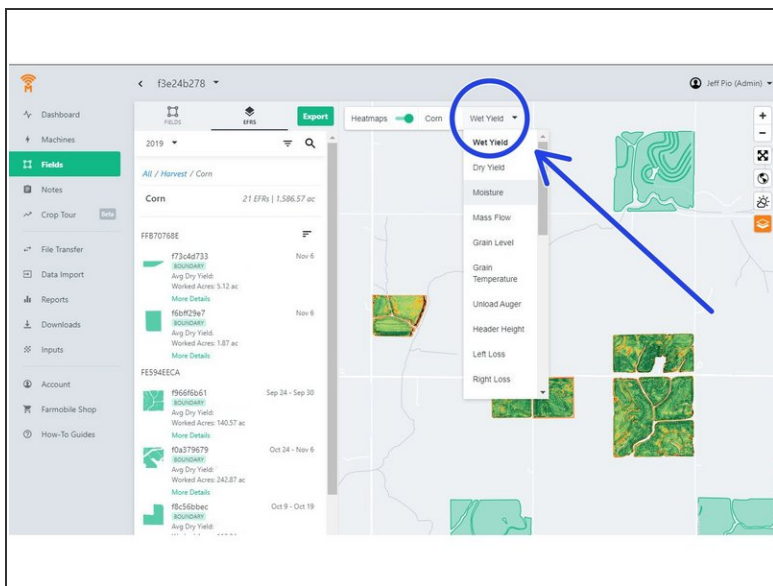
- From the Fields tab, select EFRs
- By selecting the EFRs, the different EFR activities are categorized.
- Users can select an activity they would like to see heatmaps for.
- In this example, after selecting harvesting EFRs, all field boundaries that have data will show yield heatmaps.

Step 3 — Select Crop Type



- Users can also filter by crop by:
 - Selecting the desired crop in the column to the left of the map.
 - Or, by selecting a crop in the crop selector in the above portion of the map.

Step 4 — Changing Mapped Attribute



- To change which attribute is mapped out, users can select data they would like to see in the drop-down selector box. This allows users to select different attributes within a fields displayed.
