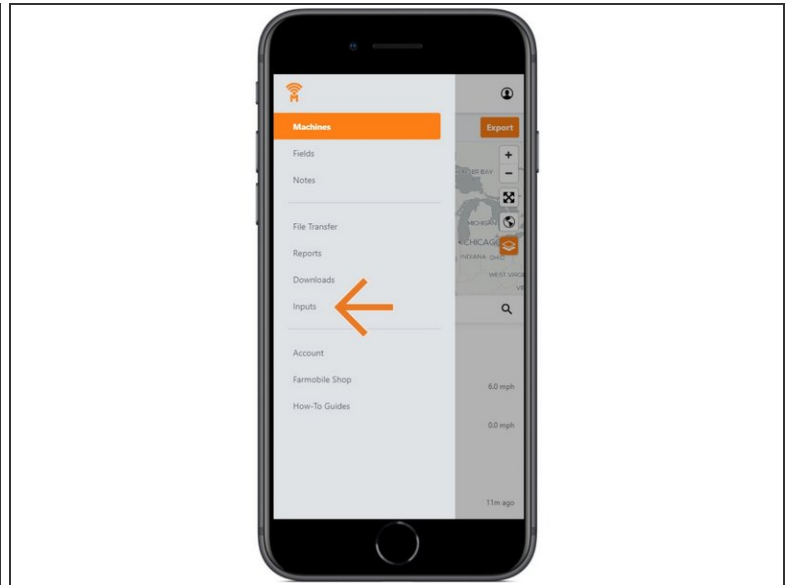

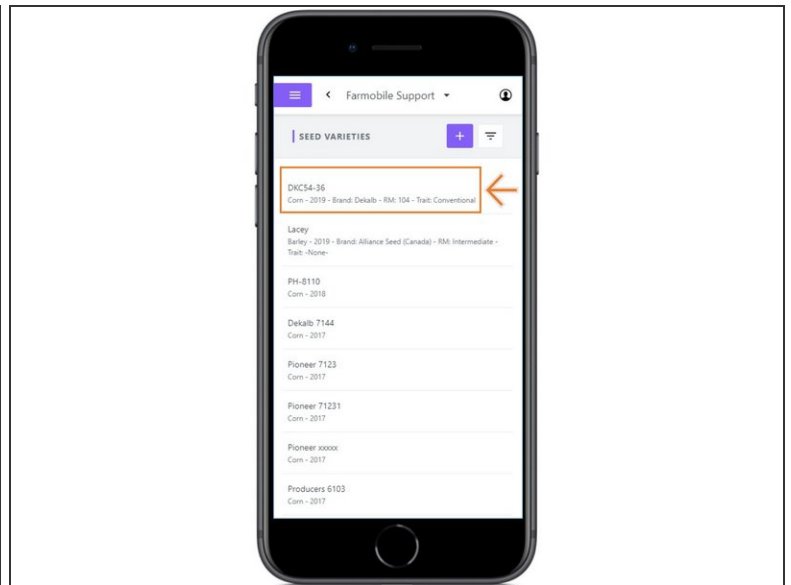
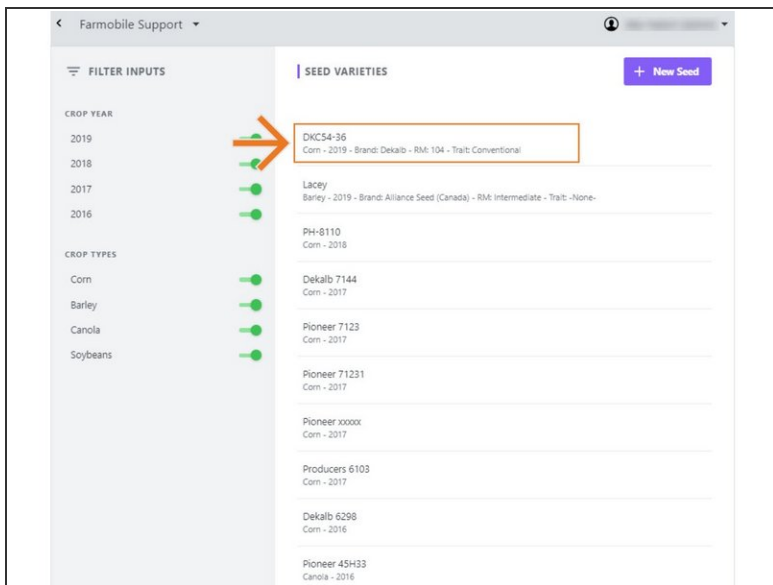
- User has the ability to delete an existing input.

Step 1 — Select Inputs from the Farmobile DataEngineSM Menu



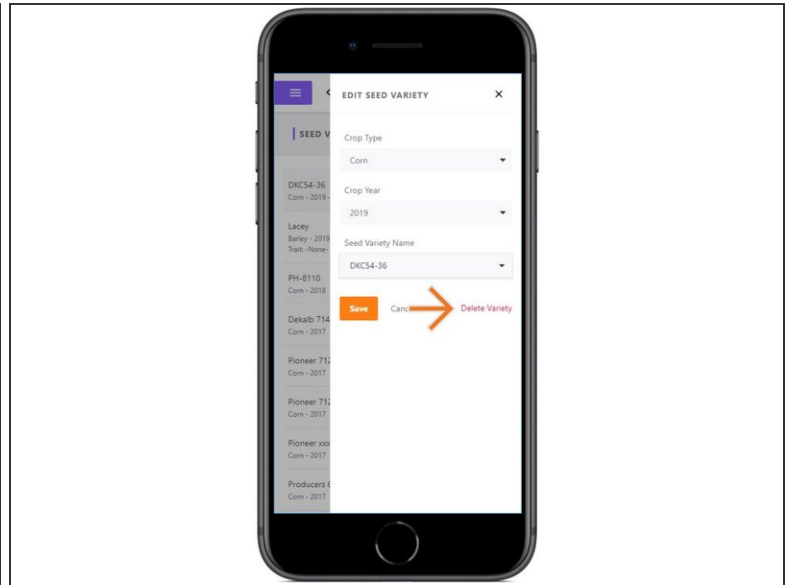
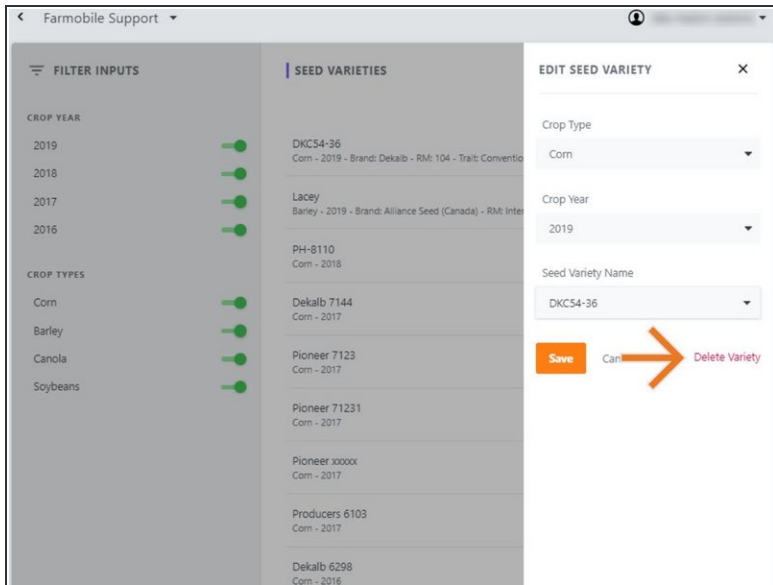
- Selecting Inputs from the Farmobile DataEngine menu will open the Inputs page with all of your inputs listed to review.

Step 2 — Select an Input from the list



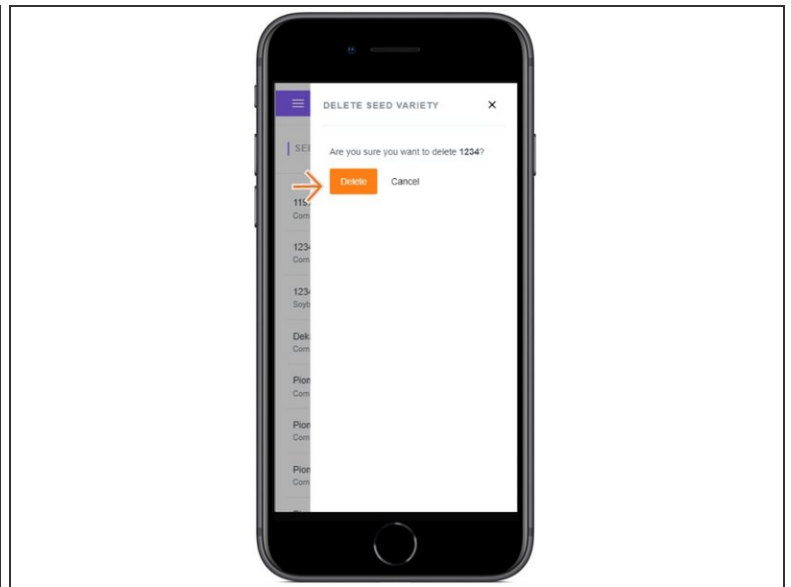
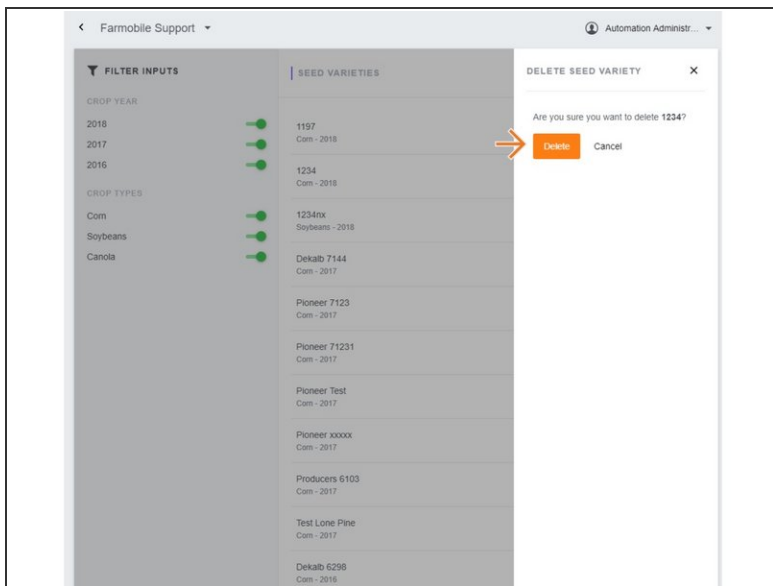
- Select an Input record to open the Edit Seed Variety window.

Step 3 — Select Delete Variety



- Within the Edit Seed Variety window, select 'Delete Variety'.
- **NOTE:** If an input has been associated to a Certified EFR you are **NOT** allowed to delete it.

Step 4 — Confirm and Delete



- Confirm that you want to delete the selected 'Input'.
- Select 'Delete' to remove the Input record from your Input list.
