




- Adding inputs is essential for data integrity and allows the user to add specific Seed Varieties to Planting Activity.

Step 1 — Select Inputs from the Farmobile DataEngineSM Menu





- Selecting Inputs from the Farmobile DataEngine menu will open the Inputs page with all your inputs listed to review.
